

Dear Wartburg Student:

You have qualified to receive funds through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act in response to the 2020 Coronavirus Pandemic. HEERF provides more than \$14 billion in emergency funding to higher education. Of those funds, more than \$6 billion must go directly to students in the form of emergency financial aid grants (HEERF is the student share) for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the COVID-19 crisis.

Our method for determining which students are eligible to receive the HEERF funds and how to determine amount provided for each student was based on the HEERF definition of a residential student and, if the student is eligible for Title IV Federal Student Aid. Wartburg then used the following criteria to determine funds received by each student: EFC based on the FAFSA, adjusted rent and family size.
